Advantage Angus - Benefits of an efficient breeding system

Feeding efficiency is the key word that will complement the ANGUS Group in the upcoming months. Together with the Regional Office for Agriculture (LFL) in Munich, the ANGUS Group analyses the effects of different grass based feedings on German Angus cattle. The aim of this study is to optimize the efficiency of fattening results. Highest quality beef at low feeding costs is the slogan. The test with 72 male Angus yearlings has been running since October 2014. The results are expected by the organizers in June this year.

The feeding test is accompanied by ultrasound measurements. "We want to see how the proportion between the back muscle area, marbling and fat cover develops," says Bernhard Delle, General Manager of ANGUS Group. So he wants to identify the most suitable genetics for the market oriented production of beef.

By carefully controlling the beef production, all breeders and farmers and beef producers involved will ultimately benefit through better marketing results. This is the idea of the Angus system: grass-based beef production, supplemented by modern scientific breeding instruments. This is how quality products for responsible consumers are developed in nature.

We are permanently working to improve our Aberdeen Angus System. Now we are concentrating on the Feed Efficiency issue. We want to offer our partners ideal conditions for fattening. Therefore, we are currently involved in a test, with expected results at the middle of the year. Reliable quality. regional origin, short transportation distances. Many partners of ANGUS Group, including companies in the food service or retail chains, bank on Angus beef because this can be delivered throughout Germany in the required quality. "We are in the fortunate situation that we operate on market demand. Customers order a certain beef quality that must be provided by the breeding partners. Our slaughtering plan is four months in advance," says Bernhard Delle. Reliable quality and delivery is especially important to customers, and this is what they appreciate.

Export of the successful Angus SystemThe successful model of ANGUS Group is being expanded in Europe.

The basis for this expansion was laid by Managing Directors Samuel Widmer and Bernhard Delle in 2014. The focus is on agricultural markets associated with growth potential. "At the moment, we are interested especially in Central and Eastern Europe" informed Bernhard Delle. Bernhard Delle sees particularly promising the situation in Serbia. "For 20 years there has been no investment made in the Serbian agriculture. However, there is still an infrastructure on which to build on." In collaboration with government agencies and selected companies, Bernhard Delle is working on a pilot project. The project details are being currently negotiated by the leaders of ANGUS Group on site. The first farms are starting to breed Angus cattle this year. Similar projects are planned in other countries, such as Hungary.

Continuous growth

The breeding, fattening and marketing system of ANGUS Group is a successful model in the German agriculture. Since its founding in 2010, the company recorded steady growth, both in terms of the number of cooperating breeding and fattening farms, as well as the marketing partners.
